

Should I open a SignUpGenius account?

We do not require you to create a SignUpGenius account to sign up for Silverridge Pickleball Club events. In most cases, you can sign up with a name and email address only.

Creating an account does provide extra flexibility. For instance, if you log in to your account, you can see all the upcoming events for which you are invited to, have signed up for and easily edit them if needed.

There is no charge to open a SignUpGenius account. Visit signupgenius.com/register and click on “New Account”.



Manage Account Profile and Settings

Manage your account profile and preferences in the Settings area.

First, log in to your SignUpGenius account by entering your email address and password. Once logged in, locate the circle with your initials or profile picture in the upper right-hand corner.

Click on the circle and select **My Signups and Settings**. Then click on **Settings**.



You will notice six tabs at the top highlighting different settings for your account (Profile, Password, Notifications, Sign Ups, Integrations, Date & Time).

The Profile allows you to:

- Edit your name, email address and other contact information
- Choose or edit the profile picture for your account
- Merge your account with another SignUpGenius account

The Password allows you to:

- Reset the password for your account

The Notifications allows you to:

- Manage the groups you are associated with
- View the groups you can receive text messages from
- Set reminder preferences for email or texts and set preferred notification times
- Block email addresses of any sign-up creators you wish to not contact you

The Sign Ups allows you to:

- Choose basic default settings for the sign-ups you create

The Date & Time allows you to:

- Set the preferred date format
- Manage time zone setting for your account
- For Silverridge, the Time Zone should be set to Mountain and Region is America/Phoenix.

If you make changes to any of these areas, be sure to click **Update Settings** at the bottom of each page. Voila!
